

Consistency Determination (CD) Checklist

Once the administrative review is deemed complete, the public notice and technical review period begins. To ensure all information is provided and to avoid a possible delay of the consistency review for a CD, Federal agency applicants may use the CD checklist listed below as a guide for submitting consistency review requests to the GLO.

<u>Consistency Determination Checklist</u>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	A detailed description of the proposed activity and its associated facilities
<input type="checkbox"/>	A discussion of anticipated coastal effects. Federal agencies may choose to use NEPA documents or other project documents to describe coastal effects.
<input type="checkbox"/>	An analysis of the relevant enforceable policies and how the project is consistent or is inconsistent with the goals and enforceable policies.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A description of the evaluation should be included in the CD or provided simultaneously with the CD if the evaluation is contained in another document.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Comprehensive data and information sufficient to support the federal agency's consistency statement.
<input type="checkbox"/>	A brief statement indicating whether the proposed activity will be undertaken in a manner consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the goals and enforceable policies of the Texas CMP. See 15 CFR §930.39(a).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Signed GLO CMP consistency form
	CD may be submitted to the GLO for review in any format but must meet the content requirements set out in 15 CFR §930.39. See also 31 TAC §30.20.
