THE STATE OF TEXAS, TO-WIT:

I, GRANVILLE H. SHERWOOD, the Commissioner duly appointed in pursuance of the several Acts of the State of Texas, *now in force*, and acting under and by authority of said Acts, Do hereby certify, That on the *Thirteenth* day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, H. WILLKE, the Agent of the German Emigration Company, in the said Acts mentioned, appointed as such by the German Emigration Company, appeared before me, at the city of New Braunfels, in the County of Comal, and State of Texas aforesaid, and proved to me by *his own oath*, and the testimony of three disinterested, respectable witnesses, to my satisfaction, that the said German Emigration Company had introduced, previous to the first day of September, eighteen hundred and forty-seven, *Sixteen hundred and* families and *Two thousand* single men over the age of seventeen years; and that the said German Emigration Company are, in consequence thereof, entitled to receive *One hundred & sixty* Certificates of one Section of Land of six hundred and forty acres each, and *Two hundred* Certificates for one half Section of Land each, of three hundred and twenty acres, the same being the residue of *Premium Lands* remaining after deducting *One hundred & sixty* Certificates for six hundred and forty acres each, and *One hundred* Certificates for three hundred and twenty acres each, heretofore issued to Henry F. Fisher and Burchard Miller, under a decree of the United States District Court of Galveston, of which the present Certificate is one issued to said Company for *Thirty two thousand* acres of land.

Now, therefore, The said German Emigration Company, by virtue of the premises, are, by *these presents*, entitled to *Three hundred & twenty* acres of land, as a part of the Premium Lands secured to them by the Laws of the Republic and State of Texas, to be selected and surveyed for them in accordance with said laws.

In Testimony Whereof, I hereunto set my hand, at New Braunfels aforesaid, on this the *Thirteenth* day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.


