MILLER with the PRESIDENT of the late REPUBLIC OF TEXAS, and that he was *a single man over the age of seventeen years* when so introduced, and proved the same facts by two disinterested witnesses, to-wit: *Louis*

Bruner et Emil Joroth

Be it therefore known that *he the said Daniel Bocock is* entitled to *three hundred and twenty* acres of land, for which this is his **CERTIFICATE**, to be located on any of the unappropriated territory **WITHIN THE LIMITS OF FISHER AND MILLER'S COLONY**, according to the act above recited, and the act to which it is a supplement.

John V. Muesbach his heirs and assigns forever all that certain land-
certificate no. ninety eight (98) issued to me as an emigrant of the
German emigration company, calling for three hundred and twenty acres
of land to be located on any of the unappropriated territory within the colony
grant known as Fisher's or Miller's colony. Said certificate is signed by
John O. Muesbach Commissioner and dated the twenty eight day
of March A.D. 1854. To have and to hold to the said John V.
Muesbach his heirs and assigns forever the said certificate and all lands and
rights to lands which have accrued or may hereafter accrue in virtue
of the same. And I do hereby authorize the said John V.
Muesbach his heirs and assigns to receive the patent for said certifi-
cate after having located it in his or their own name or names
binding myself my heirs executors and administrators to
warrant and forever defend the title to the said certificate
and all lands accruing under it, unto the said
John V. Muesbach his heirs and assigns against all claims
