To Wm Bradburn, Esq; County Surveyor of Harris County Texas.

You will please survey for me and at my expense, under Chapter XI, Page 29, Act of the First Called Session of the Twenty-sixth Legislature, approved February 1900, the following described land, to-wit; Situated in Harris County, Texas, about 2.3 miles..... from the county site, and bounded as follows.

On the North by the A. Schauten, on the East by the P. J. Menard, on the South and West by the J. H. Callahan and the West by the Everett - original surveys

I solemnly swear that I reside in Harris County Texas; that my post office address is Cypress Gap County Texas; That i desire to have said land surveyed with the intention of purchasing the same, and that I am not acting in collusion with nor attempting to purchase or acquire said land for any other person.

I further swear that I have a preference right to purchase said land, under section 7, of said Act, for the following reasons;

- 1 This application is filed within six months from and after said act took effect;
- 2 That there are not exceeding 160 acres in said tract, towit; there are 151 1/2 acres therein.
- 3 That I was an actual settler upon said land on the first day of January 1900; Having had the same improved for many years and having paid the State and County Taxes on said tract for the same period.

I further swear that no other person has a preference right over me, Under Section Five(5) or Seven(7) of the Act approved February 23rd 1900, to purchase the above described tract of land so far as I am informed and believe.

Van Wormer: This does not remedy the matter. The error is simply this you show in the field notes covering the application of Mr J.H. Falkey, "surveyed August 31st 1900" by virtue of the application of this party filed with you on September 5th 1900. Now this is a survey prior to the application and hence cannot be by virtue of same but as it was understood that the survey was made by virtue of the Van Wormer application it was thought possible that you adopted the same for this party's application but as the record did not show such fact you were written for a certificate of such adoption and the date of the same and you merely returned the certified copy of the field notes of the survey made for Van Wormer. If this matter cannot be corrected the claim of Mr Falkey will have to be rejected on account of the survey antedating his application.
