instead of 920 as called for. By examining the  
original field notes of the R. M. Davis Preemption  
you will see while the Surveyor calls for the  
same trees he calls the distance to be 1177 rods  
I am sure the field notes cover all the land  
between the River & the S. line of the Miller  
and between the Fountain & Sec on the East  
and the R. M. Davis on the west



Referring to the above file number covering a claim in your name under the act of February 23, 1900, have to advise that action on this claim has been suspended for the reason that same covers Travis pre-emptions Nos. 1657 and 2210 in the names of J. G. Townsend and J. N. Laughlin respectively for 80 acres each and there appears to be no proof of occupancy or evidence of abandonment on file with the papers of said pre-emption claims. Before sale of this land can be made to you under your 1900 file proof of abandonment of said pre-emption claims will have to be established. The usual method followed in establishing proof of abandonment is by affidavit signed by three creditable, disinterested, resident citizens of the county in which the land is located setting up the fact that neither the pre-emptors nor any one claiming under them lived on the land for three consecutive years from the date of applications to pre-empt. Referring to the above file number covering a claim in the name of E. M. Shahan under the act of 1900, have to advise that the field notes do not close account error in latitude of 39 varas and in departure of 6 varas. Furthermore, the field notes for this survey do not appear to embrace, by its calls for course and distance, all the land lying South of the J. M. Miller survey and between said survey and the Perdinalis river, for this reason: The most Eastern East line of the R. M. Davis survey is called in its field notes to be S. 17 E. 255 varas, whereas this survey calls it to be N. 17 W. 171 varas only, - a difference of 84 varas. The said Davis survey then takes up of the South line of the James M. Miller survey (called to be 3000 vrs. in length) only 920 varas, leaving 2080 vrs. for appropriation, whereas these field notes only call this distance to be 1980 vrs., seemingly short 100 vrs. 
