

on the 27th day of October 1909, under Section 8 of an Act approved April 15, 1905, and amendment Act May 16, 1907, providing for the sale of the unsurveyed school land appropriated to the Public Free School Fund by an Act approved February 23, 1900. Said land is situated in Harris County, about 8

miles North from county site, and known as survey No. 188, in Block No. ...., beginning at the S. E. corner of the J. P. Harrel Survey, covered by P. Whitty, a well established corner.

Thence N. at 64 varas center of Hall's Bayou at 108.8 varas center of Staseoseta County Road at 543.15 varas an iron pipe a corner of a subdivision, at 782.6 varas an iron pipe the N. E. corner of the J. P. Harrel and S. E. corner of Section 3 BLK 1

H & T. C. R. R. Co. From this corner, 1335 var. N. of the J. P. Harrel N. E. corner, I find an old Fence (down) low level running W. At Hall's Bayou I find a 24" dia. 
