

Field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for F. P. Barr. Variation 8° 30' east by virtue of his affidavit and application made before J. L. Durham on the 7th day of May, 1910, and filed with the Surveyor of Harris County on the 21st day of May, 1910, under an Act approved April 15, 1905, providing for the sale of the unsurveyed school land appropriated to the Public Free School Fund by an Act approved February 23, 1900. Said land is situated in Harris County, about 16 miles north-east from County site, and known as survey No. 7, F. P. B. beginning at the south-west corner of survey No. 6, F. P. B. on the east line of survey No. 1, F. P. B. a stake.

Thence east 2031.4 varas along the dividing line of surveys No. 6 and 7, F. P. B. to the common corner of surveys No. 6, 7, 12, and 13, a stake.

Thence south along the west line of survey No. 13, 1780 varas, a stake, common corner survey No. 7, 8, 13, 14, F. P. B.

Thence west along the dividing line of surveys No. 7 and 8, F. P. B. 2031.4 varas to a stake on the east line of survey No. 2, F. P. B.

Thence north along the east line of survey No. 2 and 1, F. P. B. at 78 varas the south-east corner survey No. 1, and the north-east corner survey No. 2, F. P. B. in all 1780 varas to the place of beginning.
