Field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for F. P. Barr. Variation 8° 30' east, by virtue of his affidavit and application made before J. L. Durham, on the seventh day of May, 1910, and filed with the Surveyor of Harris County on the twenty-first day of May, 1910, under Section 8 of an Act approved April 15, 1905, providing for the sale of the unsurveyed school land appropriated to the Public Free School Fund by an Act approved February 23, 1900. Said land is situated in Harris County, about 16 miles north-east from County site, and known as survey No. 9, in Block No. F. P. B. beginning at the south-west corner of survey No. 8, F. P. B. on the east line of survey No. 3, F. P. B. a stake.

Thence east along the line dividing survey No. 8 and 9, 2031.4 varas, a stake, the common corner of survey No. 8, 9, 14, 15, F. P. B.

Thence south along the west line of survey No. 15, 1780 varas a stake on the north line of survey No. 10, F. P. B.

Thence west along the north line of survey No. 10, F. P. B. at 1804.4 varas, pass the north-east corner of survey No. 4, in all 2031.4 varas a stake.

Thence north at 78 varas, and inner north-east corner survey No. 4, and the south-east corner of survey No. 3, F. P. B. in all 1780 varas to the place of beginning.
