

Dear Sir:

On June 12, 1933 this department received from you field notes and other papers relating to a 24.4 acre survey in Harris county, carried on our records under SF 13407. The field notes for this survey have been endorsed: "No vacancy, on SF 13399 and MA 27279 A C Stimson and MA 27263 Gordon McCone; see draftsman's statement within".

The draftsman's statement is that the C N Pillot (2-53), C Goodrich (B-24), J M Hooper (B-21), and Wm Hurd (B-25) surveys were all made within a few days of each other, by the same surveyor, using practically the same chain carriers, and that inasmuch as these surveys constitute a system of surveys and the field notes of one survey call for the other, they must be held to join, thus precluding the existence of any vacancy between these surveys. I have therefore, rejected your application under SF 13407.

The Comptroller will be directed to return your payment of \$77.84 which you sent to this office as purchase money, should the area be held to be unsurveyed or scrap land belonging to the State.
