BUT IT CANNOT BE SOLD, ALIENATED, OR MORTGAGED,

AND IS EXEMPT FROM EXECUTION

DURING THE LIFE-TIME OF THE PERSON TO WHOM IT IS GRANTED.

4th day of January 1837





 San Marcos ^{about 9 miles N. W. from the town of San Marcos} being the quantity of Land to which
 he is entitled by virtue of Donation Warrant

No. 1111, dated at the City of Austin on the 4th day of January
 A. D. 1841, and signed by B. T. Archer, Secretary of War.

Beginning at the South East Corner of Survey No 104.
 on the ^{West} North Boundary line of Survey No 13, made for A. Wilson,
 at a Stake, from which a live-oak 9 In. diameter bears N. 25° E.
 9 varas, and another live oak 8 In. diameter bears S. 16° W. 11 varas.
 Thence South along the West Boundary of said Wilson's Survey
 200 varas - a Branch, course N. E. and at 2000 varas set a
 post at the South West corner of said Wilson's Survey, for the
 South East Corner of this Survey. Thence West 1806 ¹/₂ varas
 planted a Post for the ^{South} West corner, from which a live-oak 10 In.
 diameter bears So. 12° West 15 ¹/₂ distant; and another live-oak 9 In. diameter
 bears N. 10° E. 8 varas dist. Thence north 2000. varas set a Post for the
 North West corner ^{the S. W. cor. of said survey No 104,} from which a Post-oak 12 In. diameter bears S.
 45° E. 12 varas distant, and another Post-oak 9 In. diameter bears
 N. 25° E. 16 varas distant. Thence East 1806 ¹/₂ varas to the place
 of beginning.
