Cade a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon One Hundred and Sixty acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for on the 6th day of November 1868 by Jno. E. Campbell Surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a homestead for the period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 10th day of August 1868 that he is a married man and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a homestead under ~~An Act supplementary to~~ "An Act for the benefit of actual occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26, 1873, and that he has not a homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Joseph Kuhn and James Puryear two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that J. H. Cade the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a homestead the land surveyed for him on the 6th day of November 1868 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.


