

hundred Sixty acres of vacant Public Land, situated in said County, and surveyed for
F. M. White on the 18th

day of October 1883, by Joe L. Eve
County Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a homestead for a period

of three consecutive years, beginning on the 18th day of October 1883

that he is head of a family and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of
obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under Chapter Nine, Title LXXIX of the Revised Statutes; and that he
has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared R. S. Fortson
and J. M. Massey two credible resident citizens of said County, to me
well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that F. M. White

the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land
