Print and digital materials that are considered historically or culturally important are sometimes preserved in a building known as an **archive**. Archives can contain all kinds of things – documents, maps, correspondence, newspapers, magazines, reports, manuscripts, photographs, illustrations, and much more!

The Archives of the Texas General Land Office (GLO) cares for over 45,000 maps that relate to the history of Texas and the Americas. They are looked after by GLO **archivists** and other experts and are stored in large cabinets in a map vault.
