Task 1: Project Planning and Bidding

The CBBEP executed a contract with the Coastal Bend Bays Foundation on December 16, 2015. The purpose of this contract is to coordinate volunteer plantings at the Nueces Bay Marsh Restoration site. The CBBEP held a volunteer marsh event on March 1, 2016. The volunteers were students from Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi. The 2nd planting event took place on October 1, 2016. The 3rd volunteer planting event took place on November 12, 2016. The 4th planting event took place on January 16, 2017. The 5th and final planting event took place on January 24, 2017. This task is complete.

The CBBEP submitted the TWPD permit to transplant *Spartina alterniflora* on August 26, 2016. The CBBEP received the TPWD permit (dated September 9, 2016) to transplant *Spartina alterniflora*. The permit allows the CBBEP to transplant 4000 plugs of smooth cordgrass (*Spartina alterniflora*) for two planting events (October 1 and November 12, 2016). The CBBEP received another TWPD transplant permit which allows the CBBEP to transplant 4000 plugs of smooth coodgrass for two planting events (January 15 and January 24, 2017). The CBBEP contracted with Belaire Environmental, Inc. to harvest the plants the day before the volunteer planting. Rosario Martinez (CBBEP staff) worked on the task. This task is complete.
